

Action Center Plugin

Our VoterVoice Action Center Plugin will enable you to plug the VoterVoice content into any page on your website (what we will call the "parent page"). You will maintain control of your page. You can edit the styles and links or make any other changes you desire to the page that surrounds the VoterVoice content. Most associations create a page on their website called 'Action Center' or something similar just for pulling in the VoterVoice content.

When you are ready to deploy the plugin on your website, we will give you two lines of html code that will load our Action Center. Follow these three steps to set this up:

- 1. Place the plugin code in the <head> section of your html, as near the beginning of the document as possible. The plugin code specific to your association should be included in the email you received with this document.*
 - If you don't have access to change the <head> section, or if the <head> section is shared across all pages on your site, then place the plugin code in the body instead. It must be before the <vv:main></vv:main> tag in Step 2.
- 2. Insert our placeholder tag <vv:main></vv:main> inside the main content area of your page. This will usually be a , a <div>, or an <article>.**
- 3. Tell us the URL of the parent page where you've inserted the plugin. If the parent page changes at any point in the future, you need to let us know so we can update that in our system. This enables us to redirect VoterVoice links to your site. You *must* let us know the URL to that page, or the redirection of VoterVoice links to your site will not work.

^{*} By default, the plugin will show our /Home page, which displays your active campaigns, lets your members look-up their officials, and more, depending on your package. However, we can modify it to default to a listing of campaigns, a specific campaign, or one of our other tools (e.g.: Survey, Scorecard, etc.). Please call or email support to discuss any modifications you need.

^{**} Ensure that the area where the plugin will be displayed is *at least* 405 pixels wide (about one-third of a typical page's width).
